Dean's Measure No. 16/2022 **Extraordinary scholarship for students from Ukraine**

- 1) With regard to the current situation in Ukraine, this Measure to support students from Ukraine is issued under Article 7 of the USB Study and Examination Regulations.
- 2) An extraordinary scholarship for students from Ukraine can be obtained by a full-time student in a bachelor's or follow-up master's study program who:
 - has citizenship (nationality) of the state of Ukraine,
 - was enrolled to study at FFPW USB for the first time, after 24th February 2022 in the academic years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023,
 - is afraid of continuing his/her studies in Ukraine due to the current situation, or who has been prevented from studying at a university in Ukraine due to the current situation.
- 3) The student confirms the fulfillment of the conditions in paragraph 2) with an honorary statement.
- 4) The extraordinary scholarship will be paid monthly for the duration of the student's studies at the FFPW USB according to paragraph 2), until the end of the AY 2022/2023.
- 5) The expected amount of the scholarship will be in the range of 7,500 – 15,000 CZK per month.
- 6) The actual amount of the scholarship will be determined by the Dean's decision on the allocation of an extraordinary scholarship to support students from Ukraine. The amount of the scholarship will depend on the current conditions of the programs to support Ukrainian students, which the FFPW USB will use for these purposes, the faculty's available funds, or arrangements at the FFPW UB Dean's collegium.
